Learning Outcomes: My Time Our place

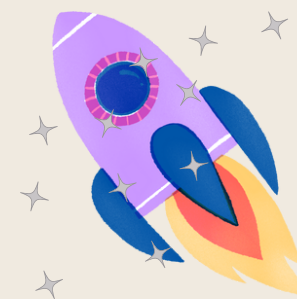
Outcome 4: Children and young people are confident and involved learners.
