

CAROLS NIGHT – THE CHANGES

To comply with SA Health requirements, we have had to make changes to this night. We must make sure that the total number attending is below 1000 people at any one time. While we have explored other options, the best and perhaps only way, we can do this, is by splitting the event into two sections.

WHAT HAS CHANGED

TICKETS

If you have previously booked a ticket on QKR to this event it is null and void. All tickets will need to be re-booked on QKR.

- R-2 CAROLS NIGHT If you wish to attend please select this option on QKR and choose up to 4 tickets per family (not including SOTS students).
- Year 3-5 CAROLS NIGHT If you wish to attend please select this option on QKR and choose up to 4 people per family (not including SOS students).
- **BOTH PERFORMANCES** There will be a small number of families who will have to attend both performances due to having children in both groups, in which case you will do an order in the R-2 **AND** the Year 3-5 area (again, do not including SOS students, even though they will come and sit with you if they are not performing).

RECEPTION TO YEAR 2

Entry to this event is via the two sets of gates on Military Road.

5:00 pm – entry for the first session, on arrival students move to their classroom

5:30pm – the carols will start for these classes

6:15pm – at the conclusion we would ask that those attending this session leave promptly

After this performance collect your child from:

- Mid-Year Receptions can be collected from their usual afternoon dismissal spot near the playground
- Reception students can be collected from Nature play end and exit via the Seaview Road gates
- Year 1 students can be collected from the MDC courts (MDC decking end) and exit via the Marlborough Road, MDC gates
- Year 2 students can be collected from the grandstand/grass and exit via the oval gates to Marlborough Rd



YEARS 3-5

Entry to this event is via the two sets of gates on Military Road.

6:30 pm – entry for the second session, on arrival students move to their classroom

6:45 pm - the carols will start for these classes

7:30 pm – at the conclusion we would ask that those attending this session leave promptly

After this performance collect your child from:

- Year 3 students can be collected from the Green courts and exit via the Seaview Road gates
- Year 4 students can be collected from the MDC courts (MDC decking end) and exit via the Military Road, MDC gates
- Year 5 students can be collected from the grandstand/grass and exit via the oval gates to Marlborough Rd or the Playground gates to Military Road

We understand there will be a small number of families that will have children across both concerts. Those families do not need to vacate the venue between the concerts. However, they do need to collect their children and have them sit with you for the second concert. Please be mindful, that you cannot allow your children to play on the playground or in other parts of the school at any time.

As this event will no longer be an opportunity to socialise, we are suggesting that you do not bring food and drink.

Audience members will need to bring their own chairs. The chairs will need to be lined across the oval, as indicated by cones, thereby allowing 1.5m social distancing from front to back. Family groups may sit close together but we are asking for a gap to be left between families of 1.5m. COVID Marshals will assist with this process.

WHAT IS THE SAME

- The event is being held on Friday December 3rd on the oval/grandstand
- Families may bring 4 people (excluding any students enrolled in our school as they will be with their class teacher)
- Families will be required to book tickets and QR code on entry
- Masks will be required when adults are not seated
- As usual please do not attend the event if you feel unwell
- Inclement weather plan the event will be cancelled

Thank you for your understanding with these changes, so that we can meet SA Health regulations. This format allows us to still have four people from each family see their child/ren preform.
