TIME:

Our Playgroup runs on Tuesday mornings during the school term and begins following the 9am MASS around 9:30 and finishes at 11am.

SPICE PLAYGROUP:

Henley Parish Playgroup is a Supported Playgroup in Catholic Education (SPiCE). This is a joint venture between our primary school, Star of the Sea School and our Parish. Our insurance covers you while you are in the hall but not travelling to or from the Playgroup.

A supported playgroup has a coordinator who plans and runs the session each week.
Our coordinator has undertaken the SPiCE Training and they attend workshops every year so they can bring you new and exciting learning experiences. All volunteers hold a current Working with Children police clearance.



Henley Parish Playgroup Activities

Activities offered during Playgroup include: - painting, sensory play, construction play, imaginative play, music time, story time and more. It is a chance for parents, caregivers and grandparents to play and interact with their children in a relaxed, supported environment.

Playgroup will begin at 9:30am with indoor play activities. At around 10:30 the children will come together with their parents/carers to listen and join in with a group story and have fruit together. Coming together as a group is an important part of Playgroup and is good preparation for kindergarten and school.

Please encourage your child to participate with you, or sit quietly to watch the group. It can be distracting for those joining in if parents are talking, so let's all sing along and have fun together. Remembering that you are the primary educators of your children therefore children learn the most from you.

Playgroup ends with a shared song time immediately following a story. This provides the opportunity for children to say goodbye to their friends, until they meet again next week.

FRUIT TIME

Please bring a piece of fruit for your child(ren) to eat at story time. We appreciate your support to encourage children to wash their hands before we sit down to eat. Please advise the Playgroup Coordinator of any food allergies that your child(ren) have and note that this Playgroup has a strict **NO NUTS** policy.

SMOKING

This Playgroup is a SMOKE FREE ZONE.

No Smoking is permitted on, or around, the Playgroup Grounds.

FIRST AID

There is a First Aid Box and Manual located in the kitchen.

ACCIDENTS / INCIDENTS

If your child happens to be involved in an accident/incident at Playgroup, you will be required to complete the appropriate form. These forms are located in the folder on the sign in table. Please speak with your Playgroup Coordinator for assistance.

EMERGENCY EXIT

In the event of a fire or other emergency, you are required to gather your child(ren) and vacate the premises. The emergency exits are located on both sides of the building. We then gather at the assembly area – located in the carpark at the rear of the building. The Playgroup Coordinator will collect the Attendance Sheet and check that everyone is accounted for so please ensure you cross your name off before leaving the assembly area.

CLEANING UP

Playgroup relies on assistance from parents so please share in the clean up duties at the end of each session. Toys need to be packed up and put away in the cupboard, tables, paint pots and brushes need to be washed, play dough placed in the containers and all dishes washed and put away.
